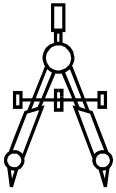

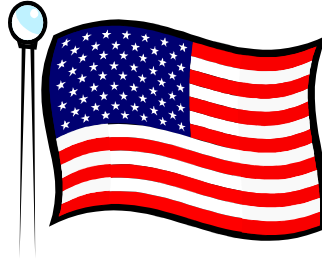
Manual of the Sword Practice
