Later in the story, he is told to think over the “thorn in the side”

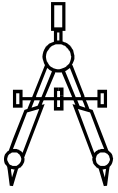

Flag Pole Memorial

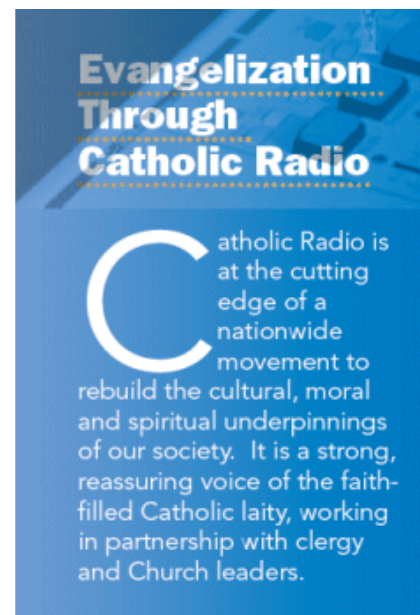

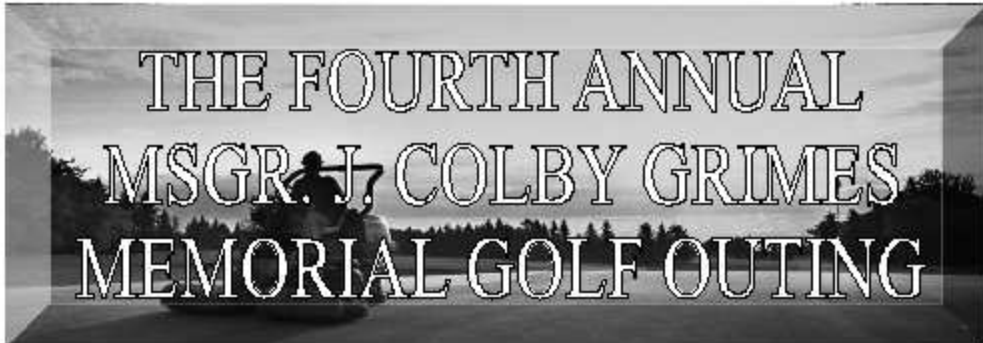
