We had a few dads helping put the ship together so the First Annual Vacation Bible School could begin at Ascension Parish. You could feel the enthusiasm and if this was a sign, then the following week would prove to be fantastic and it was! We had 54 young learners, ages four to fifth grade eager to set off around the world to learn about Our Blessed Mother's appearance at Lourdes, Knock, Guadalupe, Fatima, etc. It was a veritable smorgasbord of learning, drawing, singing, snacks out on the lawn on blankets, picnic style. It was simply fantastic. I attended Monday, funeral on Tuesday, returned on Wednesday, even better, sick calls on Thursday and then back on Friday for Family Fun Night, our Bible School Finale'. The children began the evening with a song fest, the enthusiasm had not waned a bit, and in fact it was even reaching a greater crescendo.

Face painting, drawing, games, homemade ice cream with strawberries and blueberries (Father's favorite). There was even a juggler there. I wrote this article to

emphasize two very important points for all of us. First, our fearless leader, a young mother, stood before us all on that Friday night and said, "I wanted a Bible School for my children right here at Ascension Church, so I figured if I really wanted it to happen, I'd have to make it happen." And she did! And others joined her seeing it was going to happen. The second point I was talking to her about the Bible School, she has a plethora of ideas for next year. It was nearly 9 p.m. on Friday night and a child was passing by and our Director asked the child, "What was your favorite thing about Bible School?" The child answered with outstretched arms, "I liked the whole thing!"

My dear Father, God rest him, had the philosophy of life that there three kinds of people in life. 1) Those who make things happen. 2) Those who help make things happen and 3) Those who wonder what happened.

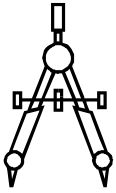

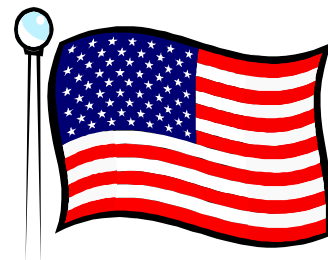
Manual of the Sword Practice
